Mum.

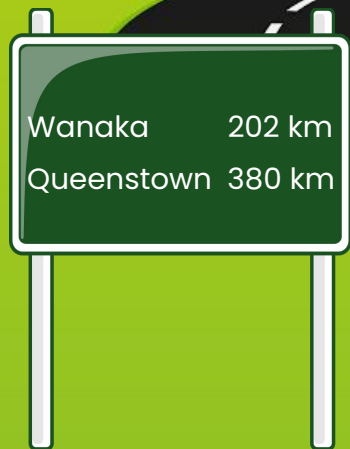


“This trip is sooo long, Mum,”
