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


Indicates an irregular sound or spelling, or a silent letter meaning there is a less-direct correspondence between letters and sounds.

Objective: To build fluency at word-level.

Options: Roll the dice and Read or Spell a Row . Repeated timed reading of all words will measure the rate of orthographic mapping.
