Indicates an irregular sound or spelling, or a silent letter meaning there is a less-direct correspondence between letters and sounds.



Penny and Danny are hip-hoppers. Penning is dabbing, and Danny is flipping and spinning. Both kids are grinning!



Poppy is a hip-hopper, but she is just sitting and chilling. Poppy is resting.





Tammy is a top hip-hopper. To be a top hip-hopper, you must be fit. Tammy got fit by going running and doing hip-hop.



Bobby is into hip-hop, and he is into rapping! Bobby is a hip-hopping rapper!





Denny is the best at tap. He can also do hip-hop, and he is the man at rap! Denny is a hip-hopping, rapping tapper!
